

# Wallingford Software Limited Software Licence Agreement

**Software Product:** InfoWorks RS Free Edition

**IMPORTANT- READ CAREFULLY:** This Software Licence Agreement is a legal agreement between you and Wallingford Software Limited for the software product identified above. By installing or otherwise using the software, you accept all the terms and conditions of this agreement.

## 1. GENERAL TERMS

### 1.1 Definitions

The following expressions shall have the following meanings: -

- "*WSL*" - Wallingford Software Limited, whose registered office is at Howbery Park, Wallingford, Oxfordshire, OX10 8BA, UK.
- "*Licence*" - a Licence granted in accordance with this Software Licence Agreement.
- "*Licence Term*" - subject always to Clause 6 hereof means a long term licence of 25 years.
- "*Licensee*" - the person, firm or company who has entered into this Software Licence Agreement.
- "*User*" - one user only who is licensed to use the Software details of whom will be notified by the Licensee to WSL upon the date of installation or use of the Software, whichever is the earlier event.
- "*Proprietary Information*" - all intellectual property rights including but not limited thereto all copyrights, design rights (registered and unregistered), patents, trademarks, designs, formula, code and other similar data relating to the Software.
- "*Software*" - each WSL software program provided by WSL of InfoWorks, including software in which WSL has sub-licensing rights, in executable, machine readable, object, printed or interpreted form and any documentation updates supplied to the Licensee.
- "*Specification*" - the technical product description for the Software.
- "*Support Terms*" - the support which WSL may supply at its discretion terms for which if supplied may be found at [www.wallingfordsoftware.com/support](http://www.wallingfordsoftware.com/support).

### 1.2 Incorporation Of Terms

These Terms shall apply to all Software supplied by WSL under this Licence.

## 2. GRANT OF LICENCE

2.1 The Software contains Proprietary Information that is owned or supplied under licence by WSL. The Licensee owns the media upon which the Software has been recorded by WSL for the purpose of delivery of the Software (if any) but WSL retains title to the Software and all Proprietary Information related thereto, including third parties from whom WSL has obtained licensing rights.

2.2 This Licence allows the Licensee to use the Software for the User for the Licence Term.

2.3 The Licensee is expressly prohibited from copying, duplicating, reproducing or otherwise transferring the Software (or any component thereof) for any other purpose whatsoever except for one copy retained for backup purposes.

- 2.4 It will be the responsibility of the Licensee to determine that the equipment upon which the Licensee intends to install the Software is suitable in all respects for that purpose and that the Software is capable of operating upon it.
- 2.5 **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH AND ADHERE TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THIS LICENCE COULD SUBJECT THE LICENSEE TO LEGAL ACTION BY WSL AND/OR TERMINATION OF THIS LICENCE.**

### 3. COPYRIGHT AND RESTRICTIONS

#### 3.1 Copyright

The Software contains copyright data (including but not limited to images, photographs, animations, video, audio and text incorporated into the Software) and Proprietary Information, which remain the property of WSL and third parties from whom WSL has obtained licensing rights.

#### 3.2 Restricted Acts

- 3.2.1 The Licensee shall not decompile, reverse engineer, disassemble or otherwise reduce the Software to a human perceivable form. The Licensee may not modify, adapt, translate, rent, lease, loan, sell, distribute or create derivative works based on the Software in whole or part except where WSL has expressly authorised the Licensee to do so in writing.

#### 3.2 Map Objects: Intellectual Property Right

For the avoidance of doubt and notwithstanding the generality of 3.2.1 above, the following supplementary provisions apply where the Software Licence includes Map Object data procured from the third party supplier ESRI.

- a) The Licensee agrees that Map Objects components may not be separated from use of the base executable application.
- b) The Licensee shall not reverse engineer by any method, except and only to the extent such activity is expressly permitted by applicable law, copy for commercial use, transfer, or assign its rights under this Licence; and
- c) The Licensee agrees that ESRI or its suppliers may enforce their intellectual property rights through injunctive relief as well as all other remedies available at law or equity.

### 4. WARRANTY AND LIABILITY

#### 4.1 Warranty on Media

No warranty is given in respect of the CD-ROM/floppy disk upon which the Software is supplied if this is applicable.

#### 4.2 Warranty on Software

- 4.2.1 WSL provides no warranty that the Software is of suitable quality or that it will be fit for any purpose. WSL has provided a Specification for the Software for information purposes only but accepts no liability in respect thereof. The Licensee is responsible for the use of the Software, all results obtained and how these are interpreted. WSL does not warrant that the Software will meet the Licensee's requirements or that operation of the Software will be error or interruption free. The Licensee hereby indemnifies WSL from and against any third party claims which may be made against WSL in respect of the results or the interpretation of those results.

- 4.2.2 All warranties whether implied by statute or common law or otherwise are hereby expressly excluded to the fullest extent permissible by law.

- 4.2.3 WSL does not seek to exclude or restrict its liability for death or personal injury resulting from its negligence but otherwise WSL excludes all liability for all damages losses expenses and causes of action whether in contract or tort (including negligence) or otherwise and whether arising directly or indirectly so far as it is permitted by law to do so.

#### 4.3 Intellectual Property Rights

WSL does not warrant that use of the Software will not infringe the intellectual property rights of any third party although it is unaware of any such possibility. If

the Licensee, is unable to use the Software without infringing the intellectual property rights of a third party then the licence shall terminate automatically forthwith without the need for notice. WSL shall have no liability to the Licensee for any losses expenses damages or claims arising from breach of intellectual property rights of a third party.

5. REFERENCING

All reports, publications and presentations relating to the use of the Software must quote the name of the Software and its origin.

6. TERMINATION

- 6.1 This licence shall continue for the Licence Term unless terminated earlier by agreement of the parties or in accordance with this clause 6.
- 6.2 The Licensee may terminate the Licence at any time by destroying the CD-ROM/floppy disk for the Software (if applicable) and all copies thereof.
- 6.3 The Licence will terminate immediately upon notice from WSL if the Licensee fails to comply with the provisions of this Licence.
- 6.4 This Licence will terminate automatically in accordance with clause 4.3 and if the Licensee shall commit any act of bankruptcy or become insolvent or go into liquidation or suffer a mortgagor or receiver to become entitled to possession of any of its assets or if any of the foregoing events are in the reasonable opinion of WSL threatened.
- 6.5 On termination of this Agreement the Licensee must destroy the CD-ROM/floppy disk for the Software (if any) and delete any copy of the Software held by it.

7. INSPECTION

WSL or any of its duly appointed agents shall have the right at any time to inspect the Licensee's premises to verify that its use of the Software is in accordance with the terms of this Licence.
